## The Inland Empire California Mayors Cyber Cup

### Competition Format

- **Format:** Virtual with teams gathering in person locally.
- **Divisions:** Middle School, High School, College, Industry
- **Team Size:** 3-6 members per team
- **School Entry Limit:** Up to 5 teams per school
- **Game Platform:** Cyber Skyline (used by the National Cyber League)
- **Skill-Building Gym:** Opens January 20 2025, with weekly practice plans provided
- **Leaderboards:** Available for Gym and Competition phases
- **Coaching Insights:** Scouting reports for coaches and participants
- **Registration Deadline:** February 28 2025, 5:00 PM
- **Awards:** Includes Best New Team for teams where all members have no prior cyber competition experience

### Registration Process

- **\$200 Fee per team** - Fee waived for all public K-12 middle schools and high schools. Private schools, charter schools, and college teams are required to pay the fee. Scholarships will be available depending on funding.
- Coaches register teams using the Coaches Registration Form.
- Coaches add team members via the Mayors Cup Coach Dashboard.
- Game codes from Cyber Skyline are distributed to coaches in early January. Coach assigns game codes in the Coach Dashboard.
- Team members receive automated instructions for registering on the game platform.
- Teams must finalize in the Cyber Skyline game platform by March 7th 2025.

### Liability and Media Release

All participants (or parent/guardian) must sign a liability waiver and release form (provided upon registration).

### Career Focused Podcasts

Post-competition, a series of podcasts, “Cyber Nuggets,” will be released featuring industry professionals who will discuss cybersecurity career pathways, internships, and apprenticeships. A “Career Launch” series of podcasts will be included and will highlight individuals early in their cybersecurity career path, such as interns, apprentices or recently hired employees.

### Team Photo

Create a team image (.png or .jpg) using group or individual photos ([example here](#)). Include:

- Student names (first names are fine)
- School name and logo (school colors encouraged)
- Team name
- Submit by March 6 on your Dashboard.

### Kick-Off Ceremony

The coaches and players mandatory Kick off Meeting will be held prior to the competition at 8:30am (March 8th 2025). It is important to join this Zoom event to hear the game rules and any last minute updates.

### Fireside Chat

### Awards Ceremony
